### *District 49 Officer Training Sessions*

The mission of all Toastmasters districts is, "We build new clubs and support all clubs in achieving excellence." To accomplish the second part of the mission, district leadership organizes semi-annual training sessions for all club officers. We're now almost through the winter session.

There have been two half-day Saturday meetings with presentations on Pathways, break-out groups for each officer position, and a very entertaining and informative panel of experienced District 49 leaders. There has also been one shorter weekday evening session.

There is one more Saturday session coming up on February 9<sup>th</sup>. All Toastmasters members are welcome to attend and it's a great place to learn more about our organization and see if you might be interested in getting more involved in its leadership opportunities. When registration (free) for the meeting is announced, it will be forwarded to all members.

### *Distinguished Club Program*



Also known as the DCP, the Distinguished Club Program is one more tool that Toastmasters has developed to support its mission of empowering individuals to become more effective communicators and leaders. It runs for the Toastmasters year, from July 1 to June 30 so we're a little more than half-way.

There are 10 goals that can be earned by each club: six for achieving education awards, in either the Traditional or Pathways program; two for building membership; one for completing a minimum requirement for officer training; and one for completing club administration tasks. In order to qualify for the DCP, a club must have either 20 members or a net growth of at least five new members.

There are three levels of achievement: reaching five goals = Distinguished; seven = Select Distinguished; 9 = President's Distinguished.

In the 13 years since DBEDT for Business was chartered, the club has achieved Distinguished status twice, Select Distinguished twice, and President's Distinguished an impressive **five** times.

Currently, we have two points and 18 members. We're well on our way to achieving several education awards and with the required membership, can expect to reach at least Distinguished status. ***But it's not just about winning an award – reaching these goals means that we're succeeding in supporting our members' personal objectives, and after all, that's why we're here.***
